Installing Baseball '94 Legends & Stadiums to Your Hard Drive

These instructions assume that you are using floppy drive A: and hard drive C:. If not, please substitute the appropriate drive name.

- After booting your machine, insert your Baseball '94 Legends & Stadiums diskette #1 into drive A:.
- 2. Type the appropriate drive name (A:) and press [Enter].
- Type install [Enter].
- Follow the on-screen instructions to install the upgrade to the correct directory on drive C:.
- 5. Start Baseball '94 as usual.

After installation, the new stadiums, teams, and players will be available from within Front Page Sports: Baseball '94:

- Your 16 stunningly rendered new stadiums, including Mile-High Stadium and the Toronto Skydome, will be available from within the Team Data, or Exhibition Play, and Game Details screens.
- Your 48 classic teams will be available in three 16-team associations—Early Times League, Central League, and Continental League—from the Load Associations and Change Team screens. Want a Series between 1931 Philadelphia and 1940 Cleveland? You got it.
- Create a new assocation and draft or trade for the ultimate all-time Hall of Fame line-ups: Babe Ruth, Bob Feller, Ty Cobb, Jackie Robinson, Lou Gehrig...well, you decide.
