IBM CD-ROM Update

Saving and Changing Game Directories

To save a game, press the [F5] key on your keyboard or use your mouse to select the save game icon on the VCR. A requester will appear titled "Save". Next, select CHANGE DIRECTORY and press [Ctrl-C] to clear the command line. Type the drive and name of the new directory (i.e., C:\DYNAMIX\WCD) and press the [Enter] key. Lastly, type the description of your saved game, and press [Enter] or select SAVE, to save the game.

To save your game to a floppy disk, use the same procedure as above, but type the letter of your floppy drive followed by a colon (i.e., "A:" or "B:"). Be sure a floppy disk is in the appropriate drive before attempting to save the game.

Restoring and Changing Game Directories

To restore a saved game, press the [F7] key on your keyboard or use your mouse to select the restore game icon on the VCR. A requester will appear titled "Restore". Next, select CHANGE DIRECTORY and press [Ctrl-C] to clear the command line. Type the drive and name of the directory containing your saved games (i.e., D:\DYNAMIX\WCD) and press the [Enter] key. Lastly, select the saved game you wish to restore and press [Enter] or select RESTORE, to restore the saved game.

To restore your game from a floppy disk, use the same procedure as above, but type the letter of your floppy drive followed by a colon (i.e., "A:" or "B:"). Be sure your save game floppy is in the appropriate drive before attempting to restore the game.

- 3. If you are using a Pro Audio Plus or Pro Audio 16 sound card for music/speech support, please make sure to run these sound cards in Sound Blaster emulation mode. If you have any questions regarding the Sound Blaster emulation mode with your Pro Audio Plus or Pro Audio 16 sound cards, please refer to your Pro Audio Manual. In addition, please select the Sound Blaster option during the installation procedure of the Willy Beamish CD.
