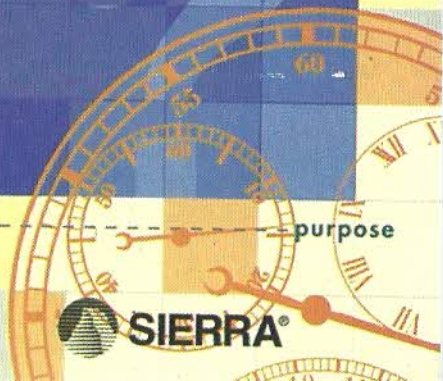

CROSSWORD DEFINITIONS AND ANSWERS

Here are crossword definitions arranged alphabetically. Look up the definition given in your crossword puzzle and you will find, in bold (dark) face type following it, the answer word you want. The emphasis of this crossword dictionary is on puzzle vocabulary and its unusual words. A regular dictionary will reveal more obvious synonyms.

In order to include the maximum number of definitions in this handy-sized Dell Purse Book Crossword Dictionary, most definitions are listed by a key word of that definition. For example, your crossword definition might be "Persian moon angel". In this case, look under angel and there you will find "angel, Persian, moon...mah". However, the definition "Persian fairy" for peri is listed under the key word "Persian" because the definition may vary from Persian fairy to Persian elf, to Persian sprite. If you do not find an entry under one word of the definition that you have been given in your puzzle, look for it under the other words of the definition.

The words following the definition are arranged alphabetically, according to length. When a definition fits two or more words, the word length will help you decide which one to choose.
